### • Books

Last Name, First Name. Name of book. City of publication: Publisher's name, Copyright Date.

# Example:

Greenfield, Eloise. Rosa Parks. New York: Thomas Y. Crowell Company, 1973.

# • Encyclopaedias (print)

"Article title". Name of encyclopedia. Copyright Date.

## Example:

"Ant". World Book Encyclopedia. 1990.

#### CD-ROM (Encyclopaedia)

Author (last name, first name). "Name of article." <u>Name of Encyclopaedia</u>. CD-ROM. City: Publisher, Copyright Date.

# Example:

McGinnis, Terri. "Dog." <u>The World Book Multimedia Encyclopaedia</u>. CD-ROM. Chicago: World Book, Inc. 1995.

# • <u>Video or DVD Movie/Program</u>

<u>Title</u>. Director, Producer, and/or Writer. Medium. Distributor, Year.

**Example:** Minerals. Written, directed, and produced by Michael Gill. Videocassette. Schlessinger Media, 2000.

#### • Magazine Article

Author. "Title of Article." Name of magazine. DD Mo. YYY: Pages.

Example: Markham, Lois. "A Gallery of Great Native Americans." Kids Discover. Aug.-Sep. 1966: 6-7.

# • Internet - World Wide Web Page

Author's Last and First Names. Title of web page. [Online] Day, Month, Year you saw the page. <URL>

# Example:

Halse, John. School World Projects. [Online] 26th September, 2007. <a href="http://www.schoolworld.com/project1.html">http://www.schoolworld.com/project1.html</a>>

#### • Interview

Last Name, First Name. Kind of interview. DD Mo. YYYY.

### Example:

Goodkind, Mary. Personal interview. 4 Sept. 1996.

## • Music CD-ROM Sleeve Liner/Jacket Notes

#### You will need:

- 1. Biographer's name (whoever wrote the notes/information)
- 2. "CD sleeve liner note to" Title of album/CD in quotation marks
- 3. Featured performer's /composer's name
- 4. Date of CD Production
- 5. Format (Compact Disk/DVD etc.)
- 6. Publication information (record company that produced/published the album)

### Organise it like this:

Biographer's name (Last, First name), "CD sleeve liner note to" Title of album/CD in quotation marks. Featured performer's/composer's name. Date of CD Production. Format (Compact Disk/DVD etc.). Publication information.

### Example:

Hilgert, Alan. CD sleeve liner note to "Ella Fitzgerald sings the Rodgers and Hart Song Book." Ella Fitzgerald. 1997. Compact Disk. Geffen Records.
