1. On what day in December do the children in the Netherlands receive their presents from Sinterklaas?
2. Who has a dog called Max?
3. What are the names of the bandits in the movie Home Alone?
4. What Christmas present does Harry receive from Dumbledore during his first Christmas at Hogwarts?
5. In which famous Christmas movie would you find the “Wet Bandits” and why are they called that?
6. Who does Viktor Krum go to the Yule Ball with?
7. In the song “Jingle Bells” what is the Bobtail in “Bells on Bobtails ring”?
8. What is the name of an old Christmas beverage served in England that contains the following ingredients: curdled cream, roasted apples, eggs, cloves, ginger, nutmeg and sugar? Yum!
9. Since 1947, which country has sent a huge Christmas tree to London in the UK? Spell the name of the country in their language, as they would write it.
10. What did people in Germany used to illuminate their Christmas trees with?
11. What does Schwartz say he's going to get his dad for Christmas?
12. What is the name of the old custom where men and women would swap clothes, wear masks, visit their neighbours, sing, dance and put on a play with a silly plot to make people laugh? Who did the leader dress up as?

13. What is the real name of the actor who, in a Christmas movie from 1989, actually broke his pinky finger while punching a plastic Santa Clause in a scene from the movie?
