Styles of Jazz - Power Point Presentation.

You will be creating a power point presentation on the different styles of Jazz.

Your presentations should have at least 9 slides that cover each of the following styles of jazz: Ragtime; Dixieland; Blues; Big Band-Swing; Be-Bop/Bop; Cool/West Coast Jazz; Vocal Jazz; Free Jazz; Funky Jazz.

Your presentation should include pictures on some or all of the slides.

All your information should come from the internet. You should make a note of all URL's of websites that you visit, and the date you visit them. You must only copy and paste into a word document, not straight into your power point presentation. You will then key word that information. You should ONLY use your key-word notes for the information that goes into your power point presentation. NO PLAGIARISM. You may use pictures from the internet and/or the "Division 4" Jazz Pages.

CRITERIA:

- All slides should be completely COPS'd and free of mistakes
- All slides should have a background and text colour combination that is easy on the eyes and easy to read.
- Only 1 animation per slide.
- You can get some of this information from your key-word notes.
- Make sure each slide transition is NOT automatic or timed; that is, you must make sure your presentation only moves on to the next slide when you click the mouse.

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Your first slide should have a suitable title for your presentation, your name, and a word or phrase that has some interesting significance to Jazz.
- 2. You should create at least one slide per jazz style: it must have a suitable title.
- 3. Each slide should tell about only that style of jazz:
 - a. Tell when (years) the particular style of jazz was popular in a sentence
 - b. Give a description of the sound of the style of Jazz (It was characterized by the big band sound; up tempo, horns blazing, and swinging away.)
 - c. Tell how it is different from other types of jazz (Sound? Instruments? Pace? Improvised? Vocals?)
 - d. Give the names of two major artist who are associated with this type of Jazz and the titles of two famous hits.
 - e. Tell about one major historical event that took place during the time this jazz style was popular
 - f. What instruments feature in this type of jazz?
